Administrative Matters

Minutes from February were approved unanimously.

Stormwater Staff Update

Staff provided a presentation on recent work in the Stormwater Division to supplement the staff memo. Highlights of recent work include: Emily presenting a poster on the development of the post-construction program at the 2022 Operation and Maintenance of Stormwater Control Measures Conference organized by the Environmental & Water Resources Institute of the American Society of Civil Engineers; engineering work for the 319 grant project is underway; staff are reaching out to contractors as part of an effort to create a new stormwater services contractor directory to make available to the community; the High Street construction bid is being released in March; the first Orange County Creek is being planned for March 12th-19th.

Matters not on Agenda

Robert shared his perspective in response to Quarterpath Trace residents addressing the Commission in January, and asked if the Commission was interested in any additional discussion. SWAC members expressed interest in further follow up to racial and social equity topics. Randy mentioned the Town's participation in the Government Alliance on Race and Equity (GARE), and that staff are undergoing training currently and will be providing additional information at SWAC meeting this spring.
